TIME Atlantic Standard Time year-round

POPULATION 110,000+ inhabitants, representing more than 96 nationalities.

ATM SERVICES Widely available around the island, dispensing Aruban Florins, with some also dispensing US dollars.

SERVICE CHARGE/TIPS Tipping is at your discretion. Some restaurants and hotels include a service charge that is shared among the staff.

TAXES Government taxes totaling 6% are either added to or included in the price of goods and services. Hotels have additional taxes and service charges (varying from 19 to 22%).

DRINKING WATER Yes, you can drink tap water! Aruba's drinking water meets the highest quality standards of the World Health Organization.

UN PROTECTION

Although our trade winds are cooling, please protect yourself from the sun's strong rays with hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen. To protect our coral reefs, please use mineral-based, reef-safe sunscreens.

TRANSPORTATIONS

Aruba's main bus terminal is located in downtown Oranjestad, with bus stops and regular service throughout the hotel areas. Taxis and car rental companies are widely available. Do not park in any of the yellow-lined spaces in the downtown area, as those are reserved for permit holders.

PLASTIC BAG

In 2020, Aruba made a big step in its sustainability goals, officially banning single-use plastics, including plastic bags, plastic/Styrofoam cups, plates, and food containers, as well as plastic straws, stirrers, and utensils.

The following beaches are popular for relaxing, sunning, and swimming:

ARASH

Touted for its crystal-blue water, sugary white sand, well-kept public palapas, and picturesque view of the California Lighthouse.

BOCA CATALINA

A popular snorkeling spot with excellent underwater visibility and a close-to-shore reef to explore.

TRES TRAP

Tres Trapi is unique for all of the colorful starfish you will find there when snorkeling as well as for the turtles that like to pass by and eat. Be sure not to touch them and admire them from a safe distance.

MALMOK

Located along the northwest coast's limestone terrace, the snorkeling at this beach is excellent.

HADICURARI/FISHERMAN'S HUT

This beach is one of the best flat-water windsurfing locations in the world, with several board-sports operators offering lessons and rentals.

PALM BEACH

This popular beach is home to a variety of diving and watersports operators, piers, and beach bars.

EAGLE BEACH

TripAdvisor's #7 beach in the world features crystal clear waters and immaculate sand that stretches for miles.

DRUIF BEAC

Is directly connected to other beaches in the Eagle Beach area, together forming a miles-long stretch of white sand beaches. It's the excellent setting for day-long beach fun, water sports and unique beach walks with the most amazing ocean views.

SURFSIDE BEACH

Surfside Beach Boasts a long, narrow strip of beach, ideal for gatherings and picnics under the trees and calm waters that make this area an excellent playground for SUP paddle boarding, canoeing and such.

MANGEL HALTO

Named for its dense network of mangroves, the beach here opens to an inviting expanse of shallow, clear water.

RODGER'S BEACH

This local beach skirts a reef-protected bay that proves ideal for swimming and lounging in a peaceful atmosphere.

BARY BEAC

Wrapping around a shallow, calm lagoon, this beach is ideal for families.
